**SUBJECT:** **TIB FY2018 Grant Awards**

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### *AT A GLANCE - DISCUSSION*

*Eleven transportation improvement projects in SW Washington will receive approximately \$13.2 million in grants through the Transportation Improvement Board.*

### INTRODUCTION

The Transportation Improvement Board (TIB) distributes grant funding to cities and counties for priority local transportation improvements. Funds come from a portion of the statewide gas tax.

Attached for your information is a list of projects selected for FY 2018 Transportation Improvement Board (TIB) grants within the RTPO region (Clark, Skamania, and Klickitat Counties). The TIB Board selected projects at their November 18, 2016 meeting. A total of eleven projects within our region were selected for TIB funding, totaling approximately \$13.2 million in grant funding.

### Urban Arterial Programs

- **NW Camas Meadows Drive/NW Larkspur Street.** (Camas): This project will construct a 3 lane road with bike lanes and sidewalks from existing Camas Meadows Drive to Lake Road. *Total project cost of \$6,563,300, with a TIB grant award of \$3,425,000.*
- **NE 119<sup>th</sup> Street East, NE 87<sup>th</sup> Av. to NE 112<sup>th</sup> Av.** (Clark County): This project will construct a 5 lane road with bike lanes and sidewalks. *Total project cost of \$12,502,000, with a TIB grant award of \$4,000,000. This project has leveraged \$3.1 million in regional STP funds.*
- **NE 119<sup>th</sup> Street, NE 50<sup>th</sup> Av. to 72<sup>nd</sup> Av.** (Clark County): This project will improve NE 119<sup>th</sup> Street to three-lane minor arterial standard, with bike lanes and sidewalks. *Total project cost of \$8,373,000, with a TIB grant award of \$3,000,000. This project has leveraged \$2.6 million in regional STP funds.*

### Urban Arterial Preservation Program

- **FY 2018 Rehabilitation Project** (Washougal): This project will allow the City to restore arterial road surfaces at multiple locations. *Total project cost of \$567,750, with a TIB grant award of \$482,588.*

Urban Sidewalk Program

- **NE 112<sup>th</sup> Av., NE Chkalov St. to NE 9<sup>th</sup> St** (Vancouver): This project will add a sidewalk along east side of NE 112<sup>th</sup> Av. to improve access. *Total project cost of \$149,715, with a TIB grant award of \$119,772.*
- **SE Evergreen Way, 36<sup>th</sup> St. to 39<sup>th</sup> St.** (Washougal): This project will add a sidewalk along the north side of Evergreen Way to improve access. *Total project cost of \$225,848, with a TIB grant award of \$180,678.*

Small City Arterial Program

- **Evergreen Drive and Cascade Drive, Hamilton Creek Bridge to Hot Springs Way** (North Bonneville): This project will reconstruct a major road along an industrial corridor. *Total project cost of \$841,007, with a TIB grant award of \$800,002.*
- **NW Lincoln Street, Main Av. to Garfield Av.** (White Salmon): This project will reconstruct a major collector, with sidewalks. *Total project cost of \$591,601, with a TIB grant award of \$532,441.*

Small City Preservation Program

- **FY 2018 Overlay Project** (Goldendale): This project will allow the city to restore road surfaces at multiple locations. *Total project cost of \$234,279, with a TIB grant award of \$210,852.*
- **FY 2018 Seal Coat Project** (White Salmon): This project will restore road surfaces at multiple locations. *Total project cost of \$138,505, with a TIB grant award of \$131,580.*

Small City Sidewalk Program

- **Gropper Road, NW Chesser Rd. to High School** (Stevenson): This project will construct a sidewalk to improve school access. *Total project cost of \$393,837, with a TIB grant award of \$350,395.*
