

## **RTC Funding Programs**

- RTC <u>awards</u> roughly \$12 million (+/-) of federal pass-through grants annually
- RTC <u>administers</u> all federal/state pass-through grants annually in Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)


## **RTC Geography & Functions**


